Dani enjoys different crafts with yarn and fibre, but for the most part, she knits socks! Not just any socks though, these are well and truly antique-style. Using a hand-cranked circular sock knitting machine, she creates socks just like they did in the 1880s, but with bright colours, blended wool for strength, using commercial or hand-dyed yarns. Socks are cranked out in a variety of sizes and styles for gifts, local stores and markets. Unbelievably warm and comfortable, unique and bright, these hand-cranked socks make their own fashion statement. The natural fibres of wool, silk and bamboo blends take you back to the roots of slow fashion using traditional techniques and materials. Dani is committed to learning and promoting fibre arts including spinning, weaving, crocheting and knitting, and keeping alive skills which are no longer essential to every day life, but make every day life better. Dani has lived on the Granite Belt for 14 years and find the cooler weather is perfect for someone who likes to spend cosy evenings in front of the fire with a basket of yarn on one side of the armchair and a snoring dog on the other.

Boomerang Bags Stanthorpe is a not-for-profit community group established in 2016 with a primary goal to reduce reliance on plastic bags. Volunteers work with donated reclaimed fabrics to produce reusable bags and other items from sheets, doona covers, pillowcases, tablecloths, coffee socks, animal feed bags, commercial discards and personal fabric stashes. During 2020 the group made their 10,000th bag. Bags are available for purchase around town, and at the Sewing Centre situated permanently in an impressive, dedicated space at the back of The Summit Hall. Bags cost a small fee which contributes to essential running expenses such as insurance and rent. The group regularly supports community initiatives such as providing free library bags to local schools and supports the Stanthorpe Regional Art Gallery on various projects, particularly items for school holiday workshops. The group will accept fabric donations during the event (see Facebook page for guidelines). New volunteers are always welcome regardless of sewing expertise. They will happily teach the basics and there are non-sewing tasks too. Boomerang Bags Stanthorpe are open Tuesday's, generally 9am to 2pm. 

Our members work together on everything from husbandry and breeding to shearing and classing alpaca fibre for the commercial fibre industry. Training is offered to new breeders and shearers, with an emphasis on correct fleece handling and skirting.

The Alpaca Artisans have, more recently, evolved from paddock to product. We select fibre for spinning, knitting or weaving into sumptuously soft garments in a wonderful range of natural colours. Some items can be traced to an individual alpaca. You may find a personal message from Bridgette The Alpaca or perhaps a photo of Sammy The Alpaca, telling you the story of how they spent twelve months growing their fibre for you. All our fibre can be traced back to the farms. Our alpacas are not just fleece producers. Like family, they are treated with kindness, to the highest standards of animal welfare. We are passionate about Australian Grown and Australian Made. Our members utilise their many talents, diversifying our product range into jewellery, graphic arts and homewares.

Norm was born in the UK moving to Australia in 2001. Norm became interested in art twelve years ago and started using oil paints six years ago, now his favourite medium. He concentrates mostly on landscapes and enjoys painting plein air (outdoors on location). This is a great way to get a feel for the scale, colour and mood of a location, something a photo rarely gives.

Norm feels the plein air process is intuitive, (see it and paint it before the light changes too much) and the knowledge gained is invaluable when painting similar scenes in the studio later. Norm's favourite area to paint is the valleys on the Eastern fall of the Great Dividing Range. In addition to Jester Hill Wines, Norm's work is displayed locally at Hidden Creek Winery, Ballandean; and Queensland College of Wine and Tourism, Stanthorpe.

Norm normally uses a fold up box easel into which paints and brushes can be stored. For lightweight trips he has built several pochade boxes which can be used on the knee, table, or camera tripod. 


